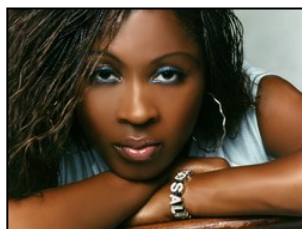


In February of 2009 Tim was promoted to Musical Director and continues to perform as the guitarist in what he considers to be the best band in the business.

Drummer Steve Williams has toured, performed, and recorded with major artists around the world, including Sade, David



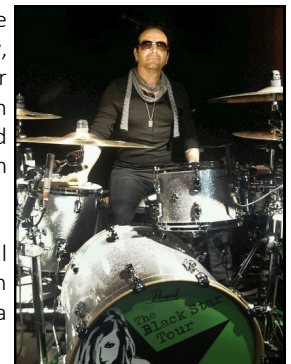
